- A master course (Bologna Process):

• General Profile for teacher's performance

"(The teacher) must consider the school and the community as contexts for inclusive education and social intervention, aiming at the pupils complete development for democratic citizenship"

"(The teacher) must develop pedagogical differentiation strategies for the achievement of each pupil, taking into account their social diversity and heterogeneity (...)

(...) must organise support activities and cooperate in the detection and intervention of children with educational special needs"

Decree-Law nº 240/2001, 30th August

National Council for Education

- an advisory body for educational policies
- composed of representatives of different social, cultural and economic forces
- cooperate to achieve consensus and recommendations for the improvement of education

"The teachers are the key factor in the educational process: they must transform objectives into effective teaching practices and these practices sould be materialised in appropriate learning outcomes.
