Abstract

A set of ideas for quick and easy activities to carry out with children, young people and adult learners who are learning to use an augmentative communication aid.

Main findings (in English - maximum 500 words) The book is a practical guide aiming to supply ideas and activities that could be useful for youngsters who use augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) by:

- providing a reason to ensure that the communication aid or Talker is always available, charged and ready for daily use;
- filling gaps in the school day with constructive activities;
- helping the learner use their Talker to enjoy interactions with others and build social and communicative experiences.
