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'Shadowing' student panels in national policy development process



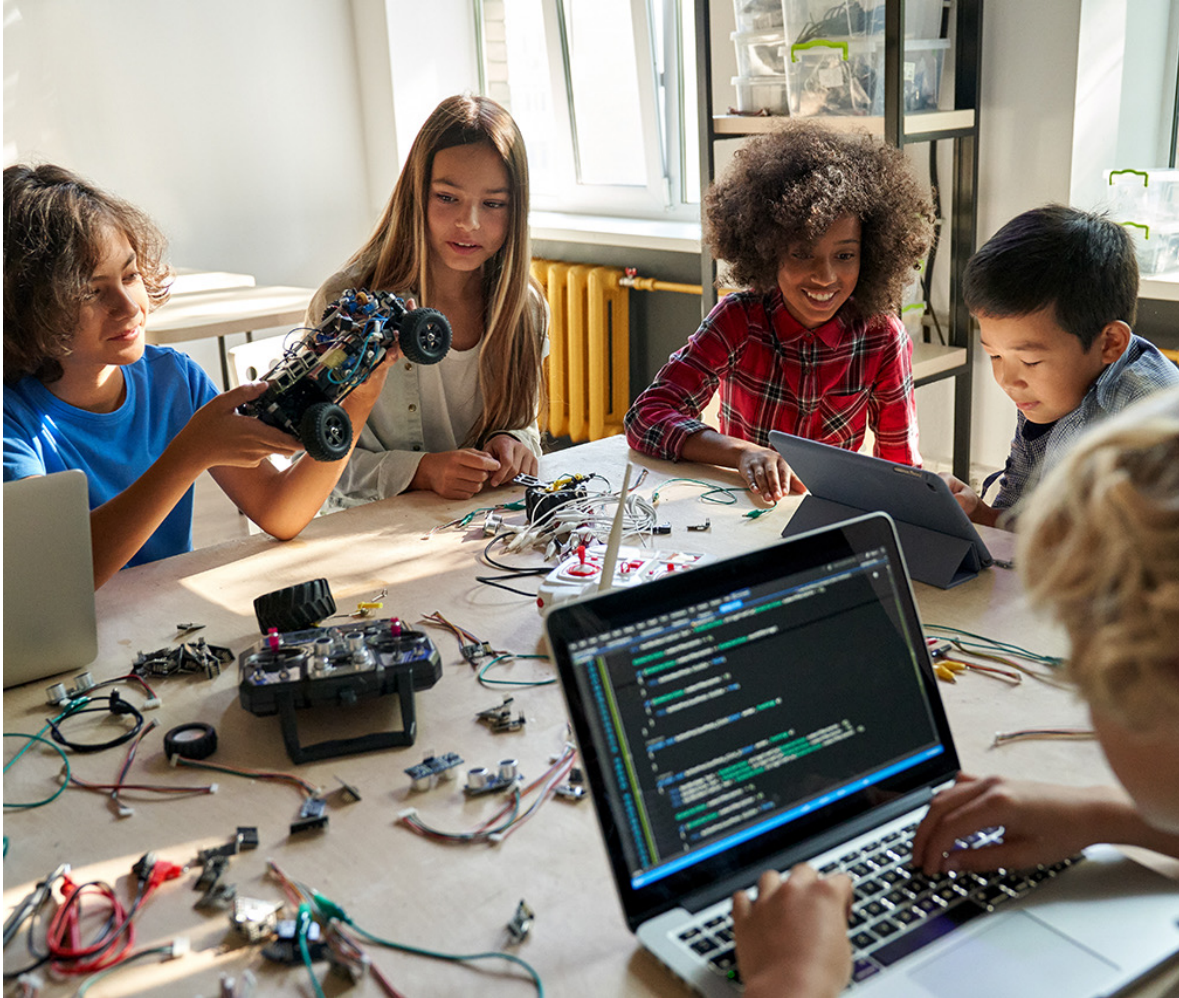
- The Norwegian Ministry for Education and Research is working on a White Paper (i.e. a policy document for future legislation) regarding young people and school.

Public is aware of the consultation process



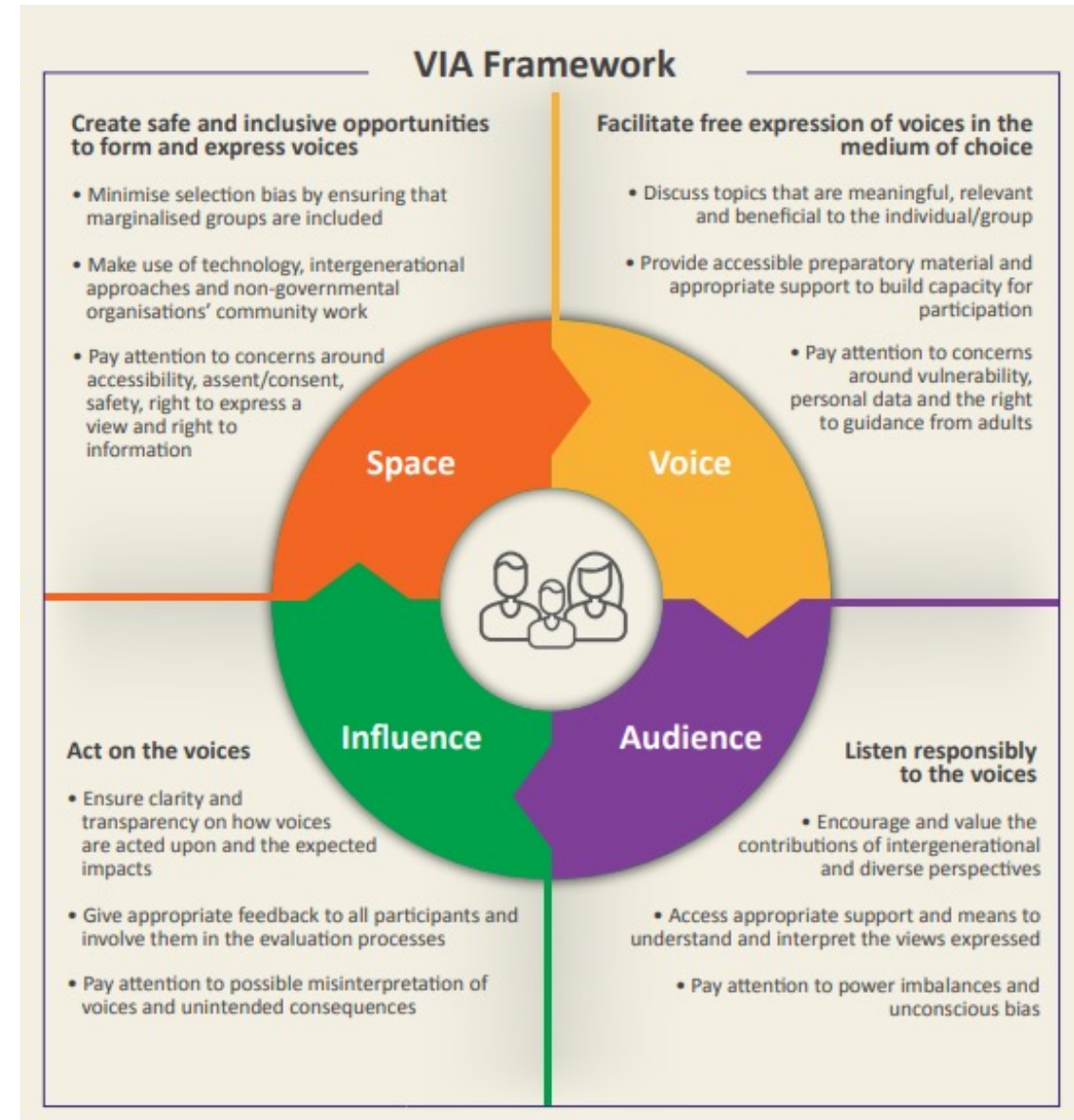
Practical and ethical issues
