



## HUNGARY – ANNEX 6 OF ACT CXC OF 2011 ON NATIONAL PUBLIC EDUCATION

### Kindergarten

The weekly timeframe of kindergarten education is 61 hours per week. The kindergarten operator organises healthcare and pedagogy for children with difficulties in integration, learning and behaviour, and with special educational needs within a weekly timeframe of 11 hours (per group).

### Explanation

The 'Authorised weekly timeframe of lessons':

- includes the 'Classroom and physical training lessons per week';
- includes the 'Rehabilitation lessons per week' for learners with SEN;
- are the other non-compulsory lessons (not in the grid);
- can include 'Extra religion lessons in religious institutions' (if the educational institution is maintained by a church);



- can include 'Extra lessons in 6 and 8 grade secondary schools' (if the educational institution's type is 6 and 8 grade secondary school);
- can include the 'Extra lessons in minority school education' (if the educational institution is maintained by a minority).

For example:

In the first grade, if there are learners with an intellectual disability in the class and the school is not a minority or religious institution:

- The 'Authorised weekly timeframe of lessons' is 52.
- The 'Classroom and physical training lessons per week' is 25.
- The 'Rehabilitation lessons per week' for learners with SEN is 3.
- The 'free-use' timeframe per classes for non-compulsory other activities is therefore 24 ( $52-25-3 = 24$ ).
