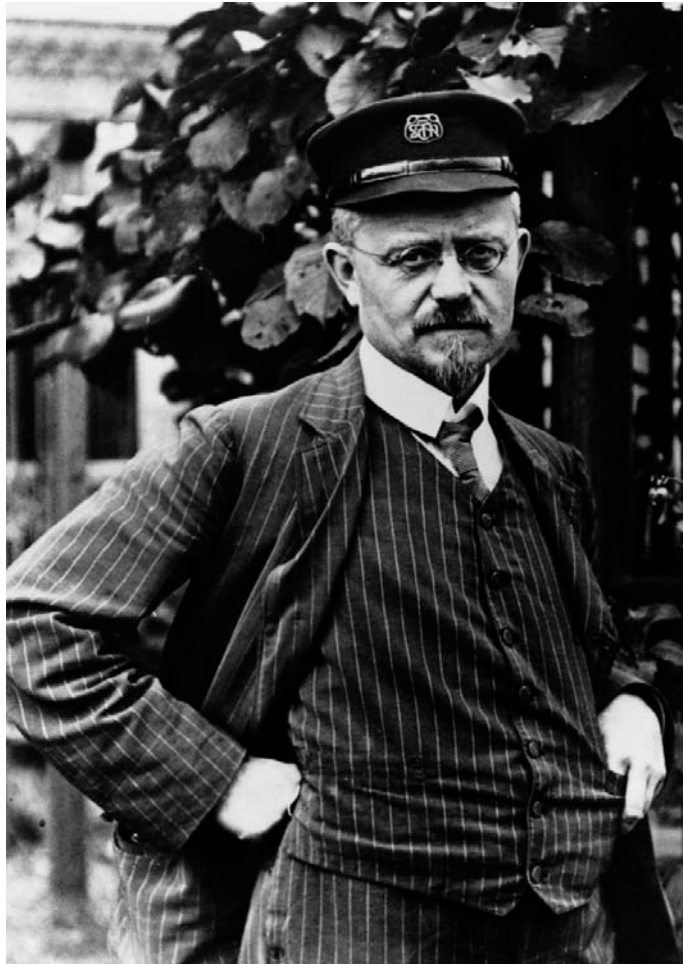

Horch established the left-hand drive

„Audi“ = latin translation of german word
„Horch“ = Listen!

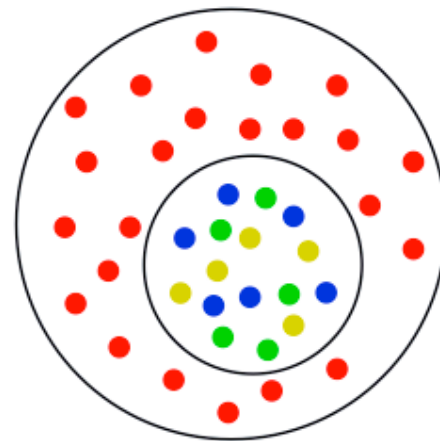

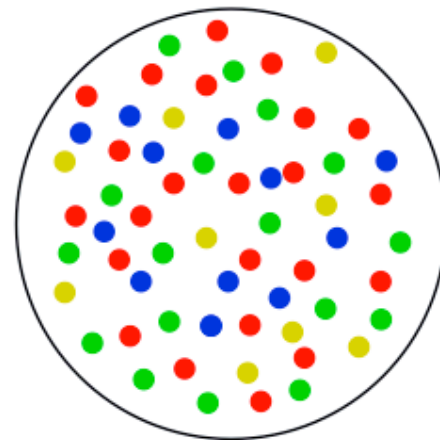

Learner with hearing impairment

- Apprentice for electrical technician at RWE (energy supply)
- 20 years old
- Born with total deafness
- Very good tennis player (world championships for handicapped people)
- Absolutely does not like special status
- Has left special school for hearing-impaired people

Class with this student

Class BSEBT10

- Apprentices for electrical technician
- 29 male learners
- In vocational training for 1,8 years of 3,5 years
- 4 weeks ago: part 1 of their exam
part two will follow at the end of the 3,5 years

Learner with hearing impairment

- Exam results
 - Practical: 98 %
 - Theoretical: 66 % (and absolutely happy with it)

Special training for teachers

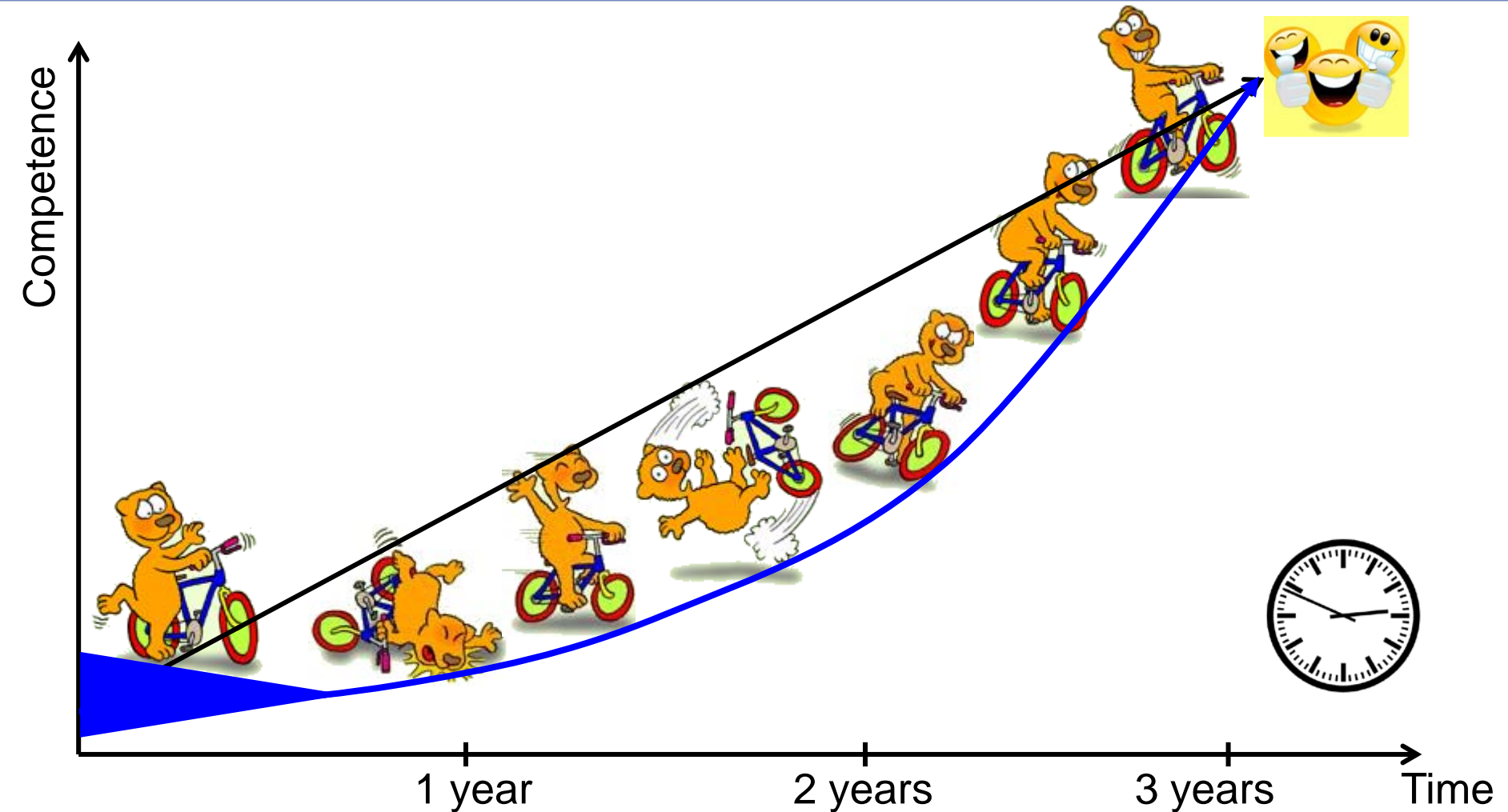
- The student started vocational training in August 2010
- July 2010: one day special information for teachers about hearing impairment
- March 2011: visit of external special teacher to evaluate (and improve) teaching

Effects on daily teaching

- Talk face to face to this student
- No need to talk loud
- If you repeat, repeat in the same words
- Visualize as much as possible
- The student should sit close to the teacher
- If anybody behind the student talks, he can not read it
=> teacher has to repeat
- Personal experience: give time and confidence and respect => talking to him far from impossible
