



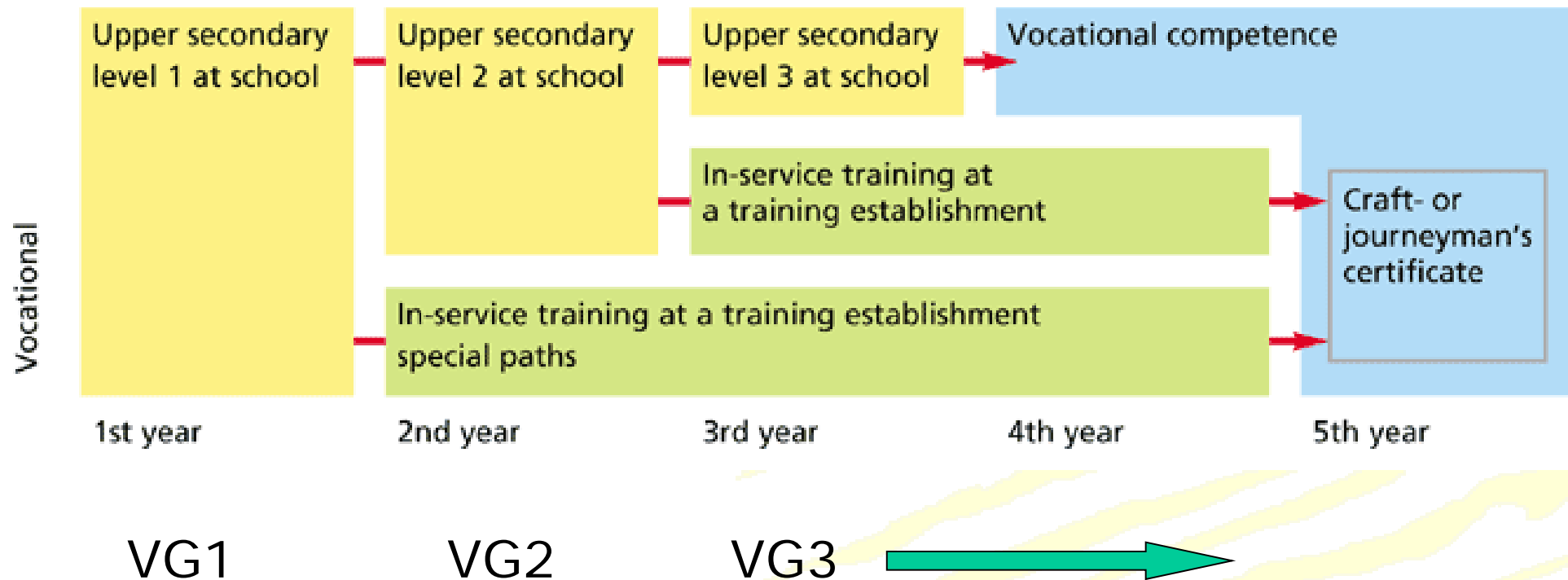

Certified training establishments for VG3

Must provide a plan for training which shows how they will meet all the requirements in the curriculum:

- Apprentice: all the requirements in the curriculum
- Training candidate: determine a plan for each candidate



Alternative training options

- Combine education at school with placements at training establishments.
- Introductory year that combines several education programmes



Follow-up services

Students who have the right to secondary education, but do not apply or gain entry to school – get referred to the "follow-up services".

The right to secondary education entitles all youths between 16-19 years entry to school or alternative pathways.



Extended learning entitlement

- If you are entitled to special education classes, then you are also entitled to upper secondary education and training for up to 2 extra years – a maximum of 5 years – if your need is related to the goals that are set for your education. Upon applying for an extended right, you must enclose an expert appraisal from the Educational Psychology Services.
- If you have lost a major portion of a school year at upper secondary school because of illness or injury, you can also apply for an extended learning entitlement.



Skills test for training candidate

As a training candidate, towards the end of contract period you will sit for a skills test, which will demonstrate which level your training has brought you to.

A skills test documents partial competence and is a test at a lower level than the craft or journeyman's examination. You are then to be tested in terms of the goals that are established for your training.
